

## SUZON FUKS

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**SUZON FUKS** is an artist whose work bridges art, science and the environment using interactive technologies, video, photography, wearable art and bookmaking, all driven by her movement practices. She focuses on water, status of women, asylum seekers, and impact of technology on humanity and the natural world. <https://suzonfuku.net>

A multi-award-winner, she was born in Brussels, where she trained in dance, theatre and music at Lilian Lambert Academy and completed her Masters in Visual Arts at La Cambre (79–84). She has lived in Australia since 1996 where she's been Co-Artistic Director with James Cunningham, of the multi-arts organisation Igneous since its inception in 97.

Since early 2000, she has created performances on the Internet, and has become known internationally as a pioneer. During her Australia Council for the Arts Fellowship (09–12), she initiated & co-founded Waterwheel, a collaborative art-science online venue about Water, nominated for International Ars Electronica Award for Digital Communities 2013, including 1,500+ artists, scientists, activists, teachers & youth from 34 countries & 81 locations (archived since 2016). In 2021, she made, with Annie Abrahams and Helen Varley Jamieson, a video compilation "Before The First" retracing some of the internet's performance history.

Since 2019, she works with electronic waste sourced locally, creating artist books relating her experience of passage from analogue to digital technology, designing wearables by repurposing parts, performing and activating installations which are of human scale as well as miniatures used in her videos.

Her immersive video and object installations have been exhibited internationally, including a recent exhibition at the Prague National Gallery for PQ2023 and at the Magdalena Montpellier Festival. Her photography, presented in major venues, has been published and acquired by the NSW State Library, the National Library of Australia and private collectors.
